

COMPLIANCE WITH 40 CFR § 751 SUBPART 'E'

COMPLIANCE WITH EPA TOXIC SUBSTANCES CONTROL ACT SECTION 6(h)

On January 06, 2021, the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), under the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA), (as amended by the Frank R. Lautenberg Chemical Safety for the 21st Century Act) issued rules to reduce exposure to certain chemicals, as listed below.

- Decabromodiphenyl ether (DecaBDE)
- Phenol, isopropylated phosphate (3:1) (PIP (3:1))
- 2,4,6-Tris(tert-butyl)phenol (2,4,6-TTBP)
- Hexachlorobutadiene (HCBd)
- Pentachlorothiophenol (PCTP)

These chemicals have been deemed to be “**P**ersistent, **B**ioaccumulative, and **T**oxic (PBT) and the EPA has prohibited their manufacture (including import), processing, and distribution in commerce, with certain exceptions.

Parts sold by Climax Metal Products Company do not contain, nor does Climax Metal Products Company distribute the above listed chemicals.

Climax Metal Products Company will continue to review its regulatory compliances and update appropriate documentation as necessary.
